And Hezekiah wept bitterly (2 Kings 20:3). Isaiah found himself in the middle of the court, on his way out. GOD spoke to him again and said, "Return and say to Hezekiah the leader of My people, 'Thus says the LORD, the God of your father David, I have heard your prayer. I have seen your tears; behold, I will heal you. On the third day you shall go up to the house of the LORD. I will add fifteen years to your life..." (2 Kings 20:5-6)

Then **an opportunity** came up. The Babylonians heard of what happened, and they took interest. King Berodach-baladan sent letters and gifts to king Hezekiah. He took interest in the fact that the king had healed. A **grand opportunity** for God's servant to testify about Him. **Instead**, Hezekiah showed off with all his belongings and wealth. A tour through the palace and everything was publicized. God gave him the opportunity to testify about God and the miracle but instead he gave them the world – what he has accomplished – all about himself. **A grand opportunity lost!**

Then was the prophecy made and God gave Isaiah the message to give the king. "Hear the word of the LORD. 'Behold, the days are coming when all that is in your house, and all that your fathers have laid up in store to this day shall be carried to Babylon; nothing shall be left' says the LORD. **Some of your sons** who shall issue from you, whom you shall beget, shall be taken away; and they shall become officials in the palace of the king Babylon." (2 Kings 20:16-18) And we find the prophecy fulfilled. Hezekiah passed away, Manasseh took reign, 695-642 B.C. and seduced Israel and done abominations, wicked things, idol worship and God foretold that He would bring calamity to them. Then Amon took kingship for two years only (642-640 B.C) as his servants killed him for being more evil then his father. Then his son Josiah took kingship, (640-609 B.C) and ruled powerfully from an age of eight years old. The law was recovered, same the covenant; and so, he reforms the nation. What better opportunity does one ask for? BUT FAILED.
Why? (1) He was glorifying himself about his wealth. (2) He did not give glory to God. And, (3) he failed in evangelism.

From one of my favourite writers wrote: "We should be daily increasing in ability to do the precious work of winning souls to Christ. This is such a precious work, such a satisfying work! And all heaven is waiting for channels through which can be poured the heavenly oil to refresh and strengthen needy souls. The Lord will protect and guide those who will let His divine fullness flow from their lips in grateful praise, and who labor, through deeds of charity and love, to bless mankind.
